RE: ERC0246 - NATIONAL ELECTRICITY AMENDMENT (METER INSTALLATIONS - ADVANCED METER COMMUNICATIONS) RULE 2018

The Energy and Technical Regulation Division (Division) of the Department for Energy and Mining thank you for the opportunity to make a submission on the National Electricity Amendment (Meter Installations – Advanced Meter Communications) Rule 2018 consultation paper, which was issued by the Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) on 11 October 2018 (ERC0246).

The Division considers the purpose of this rule change proposal to be reasonable, recognising a key focus is on providing customers with increased choice and flexibility when making decisions on metering-related services. Should the rule change be made as is proposed, the Division agrees that the cost of converting a type 4 meter into a type 4A meter may be the most cost-efficient method for the customer — therefore delivering cost savings to the customer, the Metering Coordinator (MC), the retailer and other metering service providers. The Division also notes additional benefits may also be achieved — such as not requiring the customer's supply to be interrupted.
