Energy Queensland submission to Five Minute Settlement and Global Settlement implementation amendments consultation paper (ERC0267)

Energy Queensland welcomes the opportunity to provide comment to the Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) on its consultation paper for various amendments for the implementation of Five Minute Settlement and Global Settlement.

Energy Queensland has limited our feedback to consultation question 4 regarding assignment non-market unmetered loads, and consultation question 6 regarding clarification that all customer loads are market loads.

In relation to consultation question 4, Energy Queensland supports the proposed change to assign non-market unmetered loads to an appropriate Transmission Node Identifier or Virtual Transmission Node. However, we note that significant work will be required for Energy Queensland's network businesses, Energex and Ergon Energy Network, to identify and allocate some of these sites.

In relation to consultation question 6, Energy Queensland supports the proposed change to make all customer loads market loads, as this is expected to improve calculations of unaccounted for energy.
