


Notices under National Electricity Law



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law (NEL) of the following matters:

Under Section 102 & 103, the making of a final determination including the National Electricity Amendment (Negative Inter-Regional Settlements Residue) Rule 2006 No. 4. All provisions will commence on 1 July 2006.

Under Section 107, the time periods for the following Rules have been extended as follows:

- The making of the final determination for the draft National Electricity Amendment (System Restart Ancillary Services and pricing under market suspension) Rule 2006 to 20 April 2006.
- The making of the draft determination for the proposed National Electricity Amendment (Management of negative settlement residues in the Snowy Region) Rule 2006 to 19 May 2006.

Under Section 95, NEMMCO has requested a Rule for the harmonisation of metrology. A copy of the Rule proposal and the proposed National Electricity Amendment (Metrology) Rule 2006 are published on AEMC's website and are available for inspection at AEMC. Upon receipt AEMC publishes all submissions on its website, subject to consideration of any claim of confidentiality. Submissions should be forwarded to submissions@aemc.gov.au and must be received no later than 19 May 2006.
