3. Amendment of the National Electricity Rules

The National Electricity Rules are amended as set out in Schedule 1.

Schedule 1 Minimum access standard

(Clause 3)

[1] Clause S5.2.5.3(c)(6) Minimum access standard

In clause S5.2.5.3(c)(6), insert "of" after "respect".

[2] Clause S5.2.5.3(c)(6)(i) Minimum access standard

Omit clause S5.2.5.3(c)(6)(i) and substitute:

(i) of 30 MW or more; and
