## NEMMCO proposed changes to the registration process

The Energy Retailers Association of Australia (ERAA)<sup>1</sup> is pleased to have the opportunity to comment on the NEMMCO Rule change proposal in relation to registration processes in the NEM.

The ERAA supports the changes that clarify the registration requirements for traders and Reallocators. The changes will make the processes clearer.

NEMMCO has proposed changes to the process for transferring existing generation between parties. This is also supported, particularly the ability to quickly establish an intermediary registration for participants in relation to existing plants.

We note that the actual reduction in obligations and the details of the process is not specified and will be the subject of NEMMCO procedures. We would appreciate information on indicative procedures being made available as soon as possible.

The ERAA also supports this Rule change being expedited and being brought into force as soon as possible.
