## Re: Rule change "Changes to normal voltage" (AEMC reference ERC0148)

GDF Suez Australian Energy (GDF Suez) appreciates the work carried out by the AEMC in assessing our application for a Rule change on this matter.

GDF Suez agrees with the Commission's view that a rule should be made requiring notification to registered participants of a potential change in the normal voltage level. As noted by the Commission in the draft Rule determination, a potential change to the normal voltage level could have impacts on participants beyond those directly connected at the relevant connection point.

GDF Suez supports the more preferable rule developed by the Commission, where AEMO would have an obligation to notify registered participants of a request to change normal voltage after receiving a request from a network service provider. This provides a mechanism for participants to raise issues with AEMO before any change is made to the normal voltage level.

Although the proposed rule does not oblige AEMO to respond to any issues raised by participants, GDF Suez expects that good industry practice wold require AEMO to respond appropriately to any legitimate issues raised by participants to proposed change to normal voltage.
