## **Notice under National Electricity Law**



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law as follows:

Under ss 102 and 103, the making of the *National Electricity Amendment (Victorian jurisdictional derogation, smelter agreements) Rule 2014 No. 2* and related final determination. All provisions commence on **1 August 2014.** 

Under s 95, the AEMC has requested the *Minor Changes 2014* proposal (Ref. ERC0170). The proposal seeks to correct minor errors and make non-material changes to the Rules. The AEMC intends to expedite the proposal under s 96 as it considers the proposed Rule is non-controversial, subject to requests not to do so. Written requests not to expedite the proposal must be received by **24 April 2014**. Submissions must be received by **8 May 2014**.

Under s 95, the Minister for Mineral Resources and Energy (South Australia) has requested the *Bidding in good faith* proposal (Ref. ERC0166). The proposal seeks to make a number of changes to the good faith bidding provisions that govern generator behaviour when offering electricity to the wholesale market. Submissions must be received by **22 May 2014.**
