


Notice under National Electricity Law



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law of the following matters.

Under sections 102 and 103, the making of the *National Electricity Amendment (Confidentiality Arrangements in Respect of Information Required for Power System Studies) Rule 2009 No. 4* and related final determination. All provisions commence on **27 February 2009**.

Under sections 95 and 96, the AEMC intends to expedite the following Rule proposals on the grounds that they are non-controversial, subject to the receipt of written objections:

- The AER has requested the *WACC reviews, extension of time Rule* proposal (Project No. ERC0083) which seeks to extend the end date of the distribution and transmission WACC reviews from 31 March 2009 to 1 May 2009.
- The AEMC has initiated the *Minor Changes Rule* proposal. The proposal seeks to make minor and non-material amendments to the National Electricity Rules.
- written objections must be received by **6 March 2009**;
- submissions must be received by **20 March 2009**

Written objections and submissions on each proposal can be forwarded to submissions@aemc.gov.au and must cite the Project No. in its title.

Submissions should be submitted in accordance with the *AEMC's Guidelines for making written submissions on Rule change proposals*. The AEMC publishes all submissions on its website subject to a claim of confidentiality.
