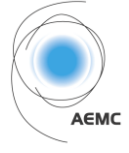


Notice under National Energy Retail Law



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Energy Retail Law as follows:

Under s 251, the Consumer Action Law Centre and Consumer Utilities Advocacy Centre have requested the *Retailer Price Variations in Market Retail Contracts* proposal (Ref. RRC0001). The proposal seeks to prohibit retailers from including terms in their contracts with their customers that allow them to change prices during the fixed term or fixed benefit period of market retail contracts. Submissions must be received by **27 March 2014**.

Under s 266, the time for making the draft determination on the *Retailer Price Variations in Market Retail Contracts* proposal has been extended to **14 August 2014**.

Submissions should be made in accordance with the AEMC's *guidelines for making written submissions on Rule change proposals*.
