Notice under National Electricity Law

The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law as follows:



Under s 95, AEMO has requested the *Energy Adequacy Assessment Projection timeframes* proposal (Ref. ERC0200). The rule change proposal seeks to reduce the frequency of Energy Adequacy Assessment Projection (EAAP) reporting while maintaining the ability to issue an EAAP when it is necessary. The AEMC intends to expedite the proposal under s 96 as it considers the proposed Rule is non-controversial, subject to requests not to do so. Written requests not to expedite the proposal must be received by **7 April 2016**. Submissions must be received by **21 April 2016**.

Under s 107, the time for making the draft determination on the *Energy Adequacy Assessment Projection timeframes* proposal has been extended to **19 May 2016.**

Under s 107, the time for the making of the final determination on the *Compliance with dispatch instructions* proposal has been extended to **5 May 2016.**
