# Schedule 1 Amendments of the National Electricity Rules

(Clause 3)

## [1] Chapter 10 Substituted definitions

In Chapter 10, substitute the following definition:

### Business day

A day that is not:

- (a) a Saturday or Sunday; or
- (b) observed as a public holiday on the same day in each of the *participating jurisdictions* (except the Commonwealth).
