

Draft National Electricity Amendment (Efficiency Benefit Sharing Scheme and Demand Management Expenditure by Transmission Businesses) Rule 2011

under the National Electricity Law as applied by:

- (a) the National Electricity (South Australia) Act 1996;

[2] Clause 6A.6.5 Efficiency benefit sharing scheme

In clause 6A.6.5(b)(3), omit "." and substitute:
