Notices under National Electricity Law

The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law (NEL) of the following matters.



- Under section 107, the period of time for the making of the final determination on the draft National Electricity Amendment (Integration of NEM Metrology Requirements) Rule 2007 has been extended to 21 February 2008.
- Under sections 102 and 103, the making of the National Electricity Amendment (Process for Region Change) Rule 2007 No.11 and corresponding final determination. Rule No.11 will commence on 1 July 2008.
- Under sections 102 and 103, the making of the National Electricity Amendment (Registration of Foreign Based Persons and Corporations as Trader Class Participants) Rule 2007 No.10 and corresponding final determination. Rule No.10 will commence operation on 1 January 2008.
- Under section 95, the AEMC is inviting written submissions and comments on the following Rule change proposals.
 - The Victorian Minister for Energy and Resources has requested the making of the proposed National Electricity Amendment (Victorian Jurisdictional Derogation (Advanced Metering Infrastructure Roll Out)) Rule 2007. The proposal is seeking a derogation from certain requirements in the National Electricity Rules to implement the roll out of advanced metering. Submissions must be received no later than 15 February 2008.
 - The Electricity Transmission Network Owners Forum has requested the making of the proposed National Electricity Amendment (Regulatory Test Thresholds and Information Disclosure on Network Replacements) Rule 2007. The proposal relates to the augmentation asset thresholds under the Regulatory Test and the information disclosure requirements for network replacements. Submissions must be received no later than 15 February 2008.
 - EnergyAustralia has requested the making of the proposed National Electricity Amendment (Compensation Arrangements Under Administered Pricing) Rule 2007. The proposal relates to the compensation arrangements in relation to the application of an administered price, VoLL or a market floor price. Submissions must be received no later than 22 February 2008.
